## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Prospective students must attend a personal tour of Champions Barber College and have an interview with the Admissions Director. Candidates must hold a High School Diploma or GED from an accredited institution.

Applicants must be at least 16 years of age for Barber's Course and at least 18 years of age for Instructor's Course. Prospective students must demonstrate the knowledge of the barber industry, the admission representative will counsel them about the overall requirements necessary to be successful. Race, Religion, Sex, Age, or Ethnic Origin has no bearing on acceptance to school.

A candidate to the Barber Instructor program must present a valid Barber License and a complete understanding of the duties of a Barber Instructor. The Administration of the school will conduct a personal interview of each candidate to determine their understanding of the Barber Insructioin Program.
